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ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengkaji pengelolaan lahan pertanian dari perspektif ekoteologis di KGPM Anugerah Tonsewer. Gereja berperan dalam memberikan edukasi melalui khotbah dan pelatihan. Studi ini menekankan pentingnya gereja sebagai agen perubahan dalam membangun budaya pertanian.

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to examine agricultural land management from an ecotheological perspective at KGPM Anugerah Tonsewer. In both global and local contexts, the church is seen as having a strategic role in fostering spiritual and moral awareness regarding environmental sustainability. This research employs a descriptive qualitative approach, utilizing data collection techniques such as observation, interviews, and documentation. The results show that some members of the congregation understand the importance of ecotheological principle in land management, such as responsibility toward God's creation and the use of sustainable agricultural methods. The church plays a role in providing education through sermons and training sessions. This study emphasizes the importance of the church as an agent of change in fostering an agricultural culture.
